## Horse Show Happenings – FALL 2010

Greetings, fellow Santa Ynez Valley Arabian horse enthusiasts! Fall is upon us and I have many fantastic show results to report to you. You all have been very busy promoting and exhibiting your Arabian horses this summer and fall and the results have been impressive. Let me share with you the following results:

### Santa Barbara Fall Show and Southern California Futurity/Maturity Championships:

Huge congratulations to one of our Valley's most impressive young riders, **Flora Elm Colone**, (very well bred, I must add, as her mom is one of our finest trainers - **Kelly Elm** and her dad is our own SY Valley news columnist – **Ron Colone**.) **Flora** and her horse, **PSYCHIC POWER +++/**, were crowned So. Cal. Champion Walk-Trot Hunter Pleasure.

**Janina Merz** (Om El Arab) and her horse, **So Om El Amaan** (trained by Ali Brady), won the So. Cal. Purebred Maturity Hunter ATR Championship. Check out the photo of the two of them – gorgeous!

**Cynthia Burkman** and her extremely accomplished Burkman Centre came home with Five So. Cal. Futurity/ Maturity Championships and 2 reserve championships. **Jullyana** won the So Cal Futurity PB Hunter Pleasure; **Miz American Dream** won the So Cal Futurity Country English Pleasure; **Backstreet Kid V** won the Maturity PB Hunter Pleasure; **Mama Mia LOA** won the H/A Maturity Country English Pleasure and **Cynthia** also went Reserve Champion on **Toi Bask OH** in the PB Country English Maturity and Reserve Champion on **HSPretty Clara Bow** in the H/A Western Pleasure Maturity.

Beautiful **Ali Brady** of the **AB Centre** had a terrific fall show, too – 2 Championships, 3 Reserve Championships and multiple Top Fives. **Josephine JCA** (owned by Jade Creek Arabians) was named Champion Hunter Pleasure Futurity ATR. **WC LegallyBlonde** went Res. Champion H/A Western Pleasure Maturity ATR and **En Avant Afire** went Res. Champion in the Hunter Pleasure Maturity. **Dori Lowe** rode **Neiman JCA** to a 2<sup>nd</sup> Place in Ladies Side Saddle ATR (her first time! Good job!!)

**Harold and Liz Green's Evergreen Arabians** did incredibly well at the fall show too, coming home with 4 Championships and 1 Reserve Championship. **Bill Porcher** won the Bridled Maturity Western Pleasure Open Championship with **EVG Megyn** and he also won the H/A Western Pleasure Futurity Championship with **Aint Misbehavin PRE**. **Harold Green** dominated the amateur divisions coming home with the Arabian Western Pleasure ATR Maturity Championship riding **EVG Monaco**, the Bridled Maturity Arabian Western Pleasure ATR Championship on **EVG Megyn** and Top Five Hunter Pleasure Senior Maturity ATR with **EVG Seneca**.



### Canadian National Championships:

**Tammy Bowles** and **TA DA** came home with 2 National Championships and 7 Reserve National Championships. **ZZues SA ++++//** was National Champion Dressage Prix St. George and **Justa Versace** was named National Champion Hunter Pleasure Select Rider with **Dana Ludustky-Green** and Res. National Champion Sport Horse Under Saddle ATR.

**David B JCA**, owned by the lovely **Ann Pejsa and her wonderful husband, Tony**, went Top Ten Hunter Pleasure AATR 40 & Over. **Ta Da** also brought home 13 Top Tens.

**Cynthia Burkman** and the **Burkman Centre** of Los Alamos once again had a fantastic Canada and came home with 5 National Championships, 1 Reserve National Championship and 8 Top Ten's. Cynthia had a spectacular ride on **Apollos Cary Grant** and won the H/A English Pleasure Open National Championship. I was lucky enough to watch that class, it was an incredibly competitive class. **Cynthia** rode to win and she and **Apollos Cary Grant** were absolutely amazing, so much fun to watch! **Apollo Cary Grant** also won the H/A English Pleasure AAOTR with Cheryl Fortun. Cynthia's other National Champions were: **HS Triftens Trinket** (H/A Hunter Pleasure ATR Select Rider); **Life of Riley** (H/A Hunter Pleasure AAOTR 40 & Over) and **MWF Benedykt** (Show Hack Open.)

Yours truly here, **Katie Russell**, showed in Canada too and I was fortunate enough to win the Hunter Pleasure AAOTR 40 & Over National Championship with **Medicine Man V** (bred by our own Sheila Varian.) **Medicine Man V** also went Reserve National Champion in the Hunter Pleasure Open with **Wendy Potts**.

### Youth National Championships, Albuquerque, NM:

**Ali Brady's** rider, **Natalie Dixon**, brought home TWO Youth National Championships in Albuquerque this summer. **Sacred Torch** and Natalie were named 2010 National Champion Walk/Jog Western Pleasure and 2010 National Champion Walk/Jog Western Equitation. Way to go Ali and Natalie. We love to see our youth riders winning in the big arena; they are our future!

### Region Two Championships, Santa Barbara:

**Ta Da and Tammy Bowles** had another super showing, they brought home 12 Region Two Championships and 10 Reserve Championships. **Bonphire SA** won three championships (H/A Hunter AAOTR 18 & Over, ATR and Ladies Side Saddle English). **Justa Versace** won three too: Champion PB Hunter ATR 18-39, AAOTR 18-39 and Select Rider (unanimous!) **Lil MissPerfet LD** won the H/A Mare Open; **HS High Power** won The Sport Horse Under Saddle Jr. Horse and **Tsaumurai Mac** won the PB



Western Pleasure AAOTR 40 & over. **David B JCA** went Res. Champion Hunter Pleasure AATR 40 and Over and Top Five Hunter Pleasure Jr. Horse.

**Ali Brady** and her AB Centre garnered three Region Two Championships. **Sacred Torch** won the Walk/Jog Western Pleasure and the Walk/Jog Equitation (unanimously for both.)

**Harold Green** and **EVG Seneca** won the Hunter Pleasure 40 & over (again!) **Janina Merz** went Top Five in the Hunter Pleasure AAOTR and AATR 18-39 and **Ali** went Top Five with **Om El Amaan** in the Hunter Pleasure Open. **Ali** also went Top Five in the Hunter Pleasure Jr. Horse with **Pure Brandy Elegance** – check out the beautiful photos of the two of them.

**Cynthia Burkman** and the **Burkman Centre** had yet another amazing show at Region Two. Her team brought home 12 Regional Championships and 12 Reserve Championships. **It's A Celebration** (owned and bred by local breeder extraordinaire, **Carol Steppe of DayDream Arabians**) won the H/A Country English Pleasure Jr. Horse; **Brando JCA** won the Hunter Pleasure Jr. Horse; **MWF Bendedykt** won the Show Hack Open and the Show Hack AOTR; Clara **HS PrettyClara Bow** won the H/A Western Pleasure Jr. Horse; **Supernatural PR** won the Country JTR and JOTR 14-17; **CWF PhantomsFortune** won the Western Pl. Select Rider; **Khrusayder** won the Western Pl. JOTR 13 & Under and the JOTR 14-17; **CMH Topnotch Gold** and **Malibu Sunset M** each won championships, too.

**Harold and Liz Green's Evergreen Arabians** once again did a fine job of representing our lovely valley at the Region Two championship Show. **Kit Hall** rode **EVG Fredrika** to win the Open Reining Championship. **Harold** went Champion Hunter Pleasure AAOTR 55 & Over on **EVG Seneca** and he also won on **EVG Megyn**, bringing home the championship in the Western Pleasure AAOTR 55 & Over. **Bill Porcher** went Reserve Champion in the Western Pleasure Open on **EVG Megyn** and he also went Top Five in the Western Pleasure Jr. Horse on **EVG Ashlyn**. **Harold** went Reserve Champion on **EVG Crystofyr** in the English Pleasure Country AAOTR 40 & Over and Top Five in the Half Arabian Reining with **RT Dun This Dun That**. **Jenn Trickey** also went Top Five in the Hunter Pleasure ATR Select on **EVG Julieon**.

**Om El Arab's** gorgeous Arabian stallion, **Om El Al Azeem** was named Region Two Reserve Champion ATH Stallion with the lovely and talented **Janina Merz**.

### **U.S. National Championships – Tulsa, OK**

The grand finale, the big show, the U.S. National Championships, was just held in October in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The show was well attended by our local SYVAHA exhibitors. Approximately two thousand horses competed for the coveted rose blankets and stunning silver and bronze trophies and many of our valley owners and horses came home winners. I must say that I was really impressed by the competition in many of the performance and amateur classes this year. The amateur and open Country English Pleasure and Hunter Pleasure classes were particularly noteworthy. There were some amazing horses and those classes were especially deep and extremely competitive. Also worth noting were the Amateur Maturity classes. We have some really beautiful youngsters on the horizon and these divisions were



highly competitive and very well supported. Here are some of the highlights from our local valley exhibitors in Tulsa:

### **AB Centre – Ali Brady**

Ali was crowned **National Champion** in the H/A Western Ladies Side Saddle on **ALADA GOLD**. Ali had a fantastic ride and what a beautiful picture the two of them made. Ali's amateur rider, Brandi Scimone, went **Reserve National Champion** in the H/A Western Pleasure AATR Select Class on **WC LEGALLY BLONDE**. Ali also went Top Ten on **JOSEPHINE JCA** (owned by Jade Creek Arabians) in the Hunter Pleasure Futurity and Top Ten on **NEIMAN JCA** in the PB Western Pleasure Side Saddle.

### **TA DA – Tammy Bowles**

Tammy Bowles came home with **two Reserve National Championships**: **LIL MISS PERFECT LD** in the H/A Yearling Filly Sweepstakes and Tammy's amateur in the Hunter Pleasure Select AATR – **JUSTA VERSACE**. Tammy also went Top Ten on **JUSTA VERSACE** in the Hunter Pleasure Open, Top Ten on **T SAMURAI MAC** in the Western Side Saddle and on **MARQUIS DE BEY** in the H/A Ladies Side Saddle English.

### **OM EL ARAB**

Sigi and Janina's spectacular stallion, **OM EL AZEEM**, was named **Reserve National Champion** in the Jr. Stallion Breeding class. Great win!

Cynthia and crew came home with a lot of trophies and plaques again this year. Cynthia's amateur rider was named **National Champion** on **HS TRIFTENS TRINKET** in the H/A Hunter Pleasure Select AATR class and also in the H/A Western Pleasure Select AATR class on **SPLASH OF FAME**. She also brought home **four Reserve National Championships**: **JULLYANNA** - PB Hunter Pleasure Futurity; **BF VITTORIO**- PB Hunter Pleasure AAOTR 36-54; **APOLLOS CARY GRANT** -H/A English Pleasure AAOTR 40 & Over and **MWF BENEDYCT** -PB Show Hack AAOTR. ## **AHA CONVENTION Report, submitted by Kelly Elm**

### **Resolution Highlights**

- 14-10** approved - Clarification - Ear plugs are allowed and not considered an artificial appliance.
- 15-10** disapproved - Controlled paddock regulating Halter paddock to one person & whip with 12" appendage (plastic, ribbon, etc.).
- 17-10** approved - Select Rider qualifications. Beginning 2012, it will take a National Championship or Reserve, or three National Top Ten's in the Select Rider division to become ineligible for same Select Rider National Class. Regional qualifications remain the same.
- 23-10** approved - Sport Horse In Hand & Under Saddle classes may be divided into Dressage Type & Hunter Type. Horses may cross enter. Effective 2012.
- 24-10** approved - Ladies Side may offer a Championship class. Effective 2012.
- 26-10** disapproved - Addition of World Cup Scoring System for In Hand/Breeding classes at the A, B, C and Local Competition Championships & ACS Shows.
- 27-10** approved - Penalties for In Hand/Breeding. Balding around eyes & muzzle, excessive grease, excessive use of whip **must** be penalized. Effective 2011.
- 34-10** approved - Working Cow clarification. Dry work **will not** be required. Effective 2012.
- 35-10** approved - Addition of Limited Reined Cow Horse classes. Effective 2012.
- 37-10** approved - Sitting trot may be called for in Hunter Seat Equitation. Effective 2012.
- 42-10** approved - Re-defining Open and Amateur Categories for Reining. Effective 2012.
